It is one of the oldest English parks in the country, with 40 hectares of botanical curiosities such as the 170-year-old cedar of Lebanon. The construction of the garden is linked to Archduke Joseph. The main facade of the former classicist castle of the Archduke, who introduced 300 species of plants, can also be admired.

56. VISEGRÁD CITADEL



Towering above Visegrád, the citadel preserves the memory of feasts, intrigues and even the theft of the crown. The courtyard of the citadel offers one of the most beautiful panoramas of the Danube Bend. And the area offers exciting sights and activities for both children and grown-ups.

DILIC MOLINITAING



Besides the historic castles, old churches, and villas, the Danube Bend is also a natural treasure to be admired. The view of the landscape is unforgettable not only from the hydrofoils cruising on the Danube, but also from the hidden lookouts, with Dobogókő Lookout offering one of the most beautiful panoramas in the country. You can also explore the area by bike on the Pilis Bike routes.

SZÉKESFEHÉRVÁR



You can walk among magnificent buildings and discover the city with one with the richest history in Hungary, which was the capital of the Kingdom of Hungary in the Middle Ages and also the coronation city. Not only history lovers should visit the old town of Székesfehérvár, but the atmosphere of the winding streets will charm anyone.

23. ROYAL PALACE OF GÖDÖLLŐ



If you want to discover how kings, princes, princesses, and other nobility used to live, visit the country's largest Baroque castle located in the heart of Gödöllő. Grassalkovich Castle, which is surrounded by a 26-hectare park, has been visited by Maria Theresa, Franz Joseph and Queen Elisabeth, Miklós Horthy and a number of statesmen and aristocrats.

ESZTERGOM



When you hear the name of the city, who wouldn't recognise the Esztergom Basilica, which with its height of 100 metres is the tallest church and at the same time the tallest building in the country. Here you can admire the world's only altarpiece painted on canvas. Take a walk up to the dome of the basilica, where you can enjoy a great view of the Maria Valeria Bridge or the beautiful Danube Bend.

ETYEK-BUDA WINE DISTRICT



The Etyek-Buda wine district is the youngest in the country, receiving the status of a wine region in 1990, and since then it has not only evolved, but the wine produced from the grapes grown here on 800 hectares has also been recognised internationally by wine lovers. Low rainfall, abundant sunshine and a unique soil composition give the fruity white wines and excellent sparkling wines their extraordinary flavour.

LAKE VELENCE



Take a trip to Hungary's third largest natural lake, whose sodium- and magnesium-rich water will ensure you feel refreshed. And after an exhausting beach day, get some exercise on the 33-kilometre-long bike route around the lake!

28. BRUNSZVIK CASTLE IN MARTONVÁSÁR



The Neo-Gothic-style manor house also hosts the Beethoven Memorial Museum, which preserves the Brunszvik family's restored Streicher piano and a medallion of the master's hair locket. The main attraction of the estate is the English garden, which features a pond and an island in the middle.

CRUISING IN THE DANUBE BEND



Cruise ships and hydrofoil boats depart from Vigadó tér in Budapest and take you to the Danube Bend with its gems, the towns of Esztergom, Visegrád, Vác, and Szentendre. The route is full of historical and natural wonders.

SZENTENDRE



Szentendre's narrow, cobblestone streets and lively atmosphere offer a magical getaway. In addition to the fabulous Main Square, museums, monuments, and churches in the area are waiting to be explored. While you are here, make sure to visit the Open-Air Ethnographic Museum of Szentendre!
