6. GREAT FOREST PARK, DEBRECEN



The city's so-called "green lungs" are treasured by both residents and visitors alike. Venture along the winding footpaths to explore this beautiful park situated just a stone's throw from the city centre, or take a turn around Lake Békás, enjoying its fountains and sunbeds. Alternatively, if you're looking to don your swimsuit, don't forget to try out the Aquaticum bath complex and modern beach area that provides great entertainment all year round.

8. REFORMED COLLEGE, DEBRECEN



An educational institution that has been in continuous operation since 1538, and whose halls have been trodden by many famous writers and poets across the years, including Misi Nyilas, Csokonai, János Arany, Ferenc Kazinczy, and Ferenc Kölcsey. Its impressive library is home to more than 600,000 volumes.

8. REFORMED GREAT CHURCH, DEBRECEN



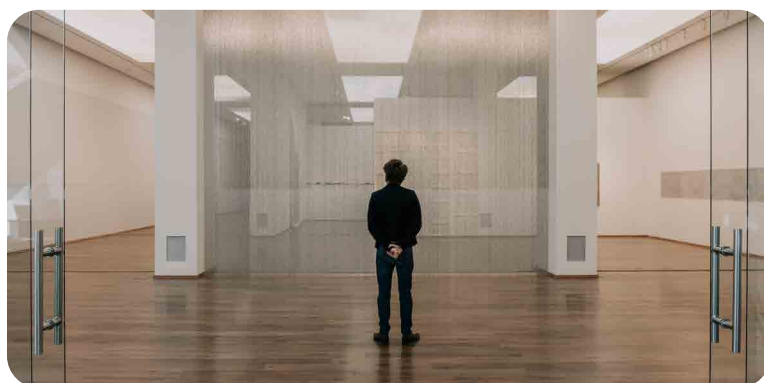
In Debrecen, everything is grand, and its Great Church is no exception. The building can hold 2,000 people and is regularly used as a venue for sung services, classical concerts, and recitals on one of the most beautiful-sounding organs in the country. Here you can see famous historical pieces like Kossuth's Chair and a Vizsoly Bible, one of the first printed versions in Hungarian, while the upper floors are also home to a number of other exhibitions.

9. DÉRI MUSEUM, DEBRECEN



In Déri Museum, you will discover one of the most remarkable public collections in the city. While the Munkácsy Room is perhaps the most well-known, other excellent and exciting experiences include the Chamber of Wonders, the Samurai Mansion, the interactive archaeological exhibition, and the Great Forest area.

11. MODEM CENTRE OF MODERN AND CONTEMPORARY ARTS



MODEM is an exciting exhibition space, an inspiring and world-class art centre. Hungary's second largest contemporary gallery, MODEM showcases one of the country's most important private collections of contemporary art.

21. HUNGAROSPA, HAJDÚSZOBOSZLÓ



Just 22 kilometres from Debrecen is Hajdúszoboszló, world-famous for its thermal waters rich in iodine, bromine, and sodium. Despite being home to Europe's largest spa complex, Hajdúszoboszló remains an idyllic small-town resort.

28. NINE-ARCHED BRIDGE



Visit the most iconic structure of Hortobágy, the Nine-Arched Bridge, built between 1827 and 1833. At 167 metres, this is the longest stone road bridge in historic Hungary.

31. HORTOBÁGY PASTORAL MUSEUM



Learn more about the unique way of life of the Hortobágy herders by visiting the Pastoral Museum, located just in front of the inn. The building was constructed at the end of the 18th century with the aim of creating a carriage house. It was a resting place for travellers, while the neighbouring inn was a place to quench their thirst and hunger. Situated at the foot of the famous Nine-Arched Bridge, it creates a truly idyllic atmosphere for a visit to the museum.

32. MÁTA STUD FARM



Visit the Stud Farm and enjoy an incredible 1.5-hour journey through Hungarian tradition. Horse-drawn carriages will take you to visit the area's native animals, including racka sheep, mangalica pigs, buffalo, and grey cattle, before the Hungarian csikósok (cowboys) show off their incredible horse-handling in a performance of daring and skill.

40. LAKE TISZA ECO-CENTRE, POROSZLÓ



In the adventure centre, use all of your senses to discover the unique wildlife of the River and Lake Tisza. The bird-shaped building also hosts the largest freshwater aquarium system in Europe.

ROWBOAT TRIP ON LAKE TISZA



You can explore Lake Tisza on your own from Spring until Autumn by renting a rowboat and choosing from twelve different water routes. Alternatively, head to the boardwalk by boat and enjoy the incredible flora and fauna on foot, taking advantage of the walkway's bird hides, bird-watching tower, and 1500-metre trail.
