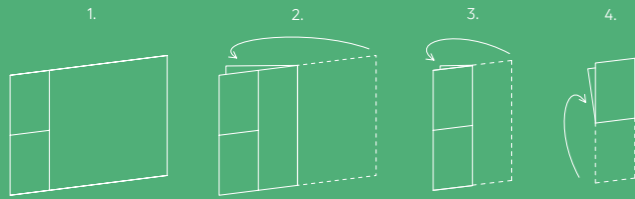

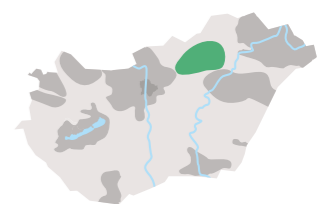

5. EGER CASTLE



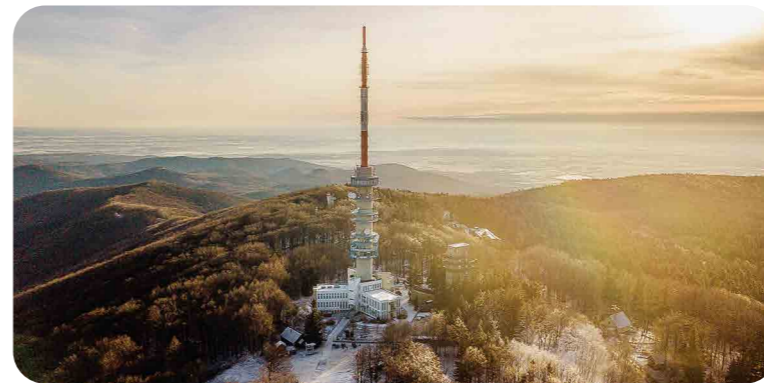
The famous Eger Castle that, no matter how many times you visit, always offers something new. The narrow streets leading up to the castle are reminiscent of the Middle Ages, and once you're in the castle, the panoramic view of the city is a must see. Today, the fortress functions as a local history museum and is home to several exhibitions covering the history of the Gothic Cathedral, Turkish war tactics, and the architecture of medieval fortresses.

12. EGRSZALÓK BATH AND SALT HILLS



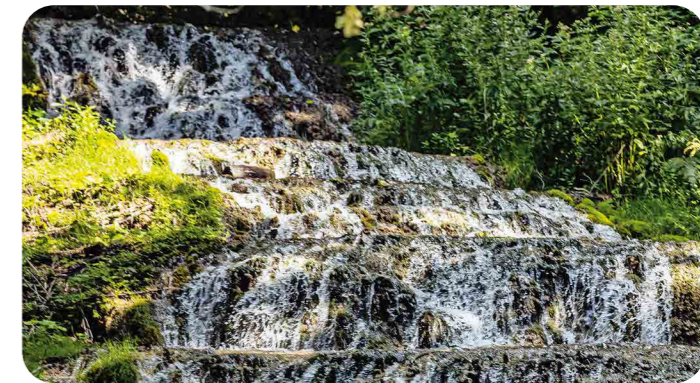
Situated in the North Hungarian mountains, Egerszalók is the jewel of Hungary's famous bathing culture. After warming yourself in the spa, admire the crowning glory of the Valley of Medicinal Waters, a unique European salt hill formed by the 65-68 °C thermal water bursting to the surface.

20. KÉKES TETŐ



From the open observation deck of the 180-meter-high TV tower of the Kékes Mountain, an amazing panoramic view unfolds before your eyes, stretching all the way to the High Tatras. With its high altitude, Kékes was officially declared a climatic health resort in 1963, which means that, in addition to the dazzling panorama, it's also well worth visiting for its crystal-clear air.

45. SZALAJKA VALLEY, SZILVÁSVÁRAD



Step into the welcoming embrace of Mother Nature in the Bükk Mountains in Szilvásvárad. The spectacular sight of the Veil Waterfall and the perfect picnic spot of the Gloriét Clearing are truly delightful places, but if you're more adventurous, you could always ascend the steep path to explore the Istállósókó Cave.

6. SZÉPASSZONY VALLEY



After your sightseeing in Eger, the region's famous wines are not to be missed. To this end, in the Szépasszony Valley you'll find cellars, taverns, delicious snacks, and wonderful wines, all to be enjoyed in the relaxing atmosphere, surrounded by lush greenery with beautiful vineyard views.

16. MÁTRA RAILWAY, GYÖNGYÖS



Starting from Gyöngyös, the train transports passengers on two lines via Mátrafüred and Lajosháza to the Szalajka House. Along the way, you can admire views of idyllic vineyards and the majestic Kékes Peak. Before leaving, don't forget to pay a visit to the Mátra Museum next to the station.

28. MATYÓ MUSEUM, MEZŐKÖVESD



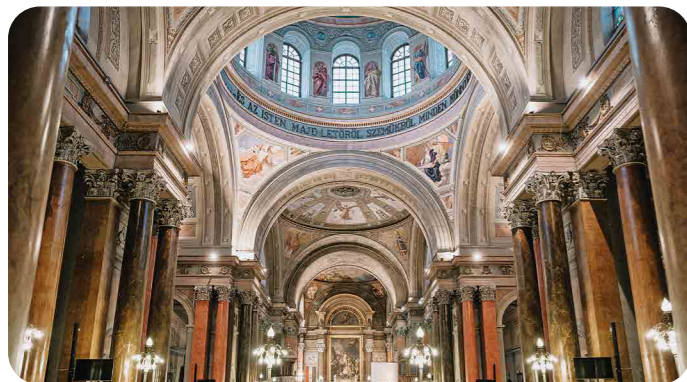
In the capital of Matyó Land, Mezőkövesd, you can immerse yourself in the wonderful folk art of the Matyós, a special and mysterious ethnic group. Included on the UNESCO World Heritage List, theirs is certainly the most famous type of Hungarian embroidery.

SIGHTSEEING OF EGER TOWN ON A TRAIN



Departing from the corner of the Archbishop's Garden in the centre of Eger town, travel comfortably to Szépasszony Valley with Dotika, the 36-person, open train. While the journey is also eminently doable on foot, the train affords you a pleasant opportunity to admire the beautiful scenery as you go.

10. EGER BASILICA



One of the city's most characteristic architectural pieces, and one that dominates the downtown vista, the Eger Basilica is truly a monumental and spectacular sight, and not to be missed. Opposite the Basilica stands the Lyceum, an equally imposing Baroque building, the entrance to which can be viewed best from the Basilica's majestic front steps.

18. ADRENALINE PARK, GYÖNGYÖS



There are plenty of opportunities for more active visitors to the Mátra Mountains. Ski lifts, toboggan runs, suspension bridges, climbing walls, quadbikes, and swings all await the adrenaline junkies among you, and once you've worked up an appetite, you can visit the buffets, coffee shops, restaurants and picnic areas.

29. CAVE BATH OF MISKOLCTAPOLCA



Europe's most unique adventure pool, where you can enjoy the comfort and relaxation of thermal waters in an incredible, natural environment. Immerse yourself in the waters while you listen to the echoes of their gentle ripples against the limestone walls in a truly unique and magical experience. Lie back and enjoy the moment!
