

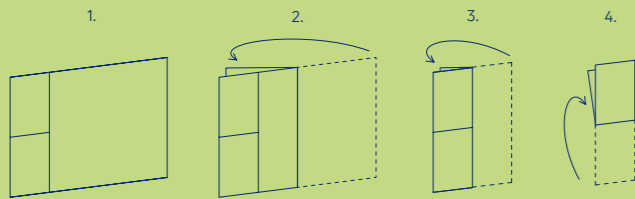

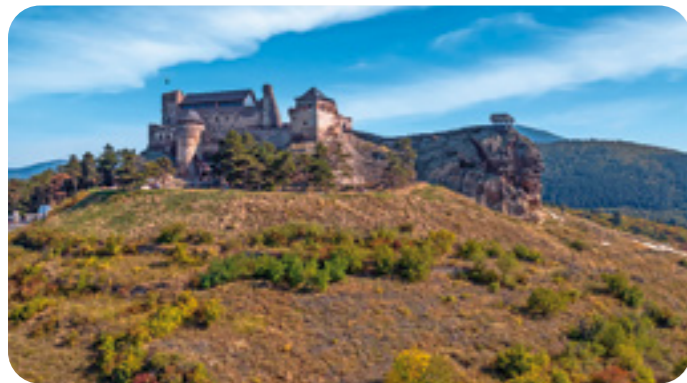

2. BOLDOGKŐ CASTLE



Originally built as protection against Tartar invasion, Boldogkő Castle sits proudly atop the ridge of the Zemplén Mountains. After visiting the exhibitions in the residential tower and palace, follow the wooden walkway south to the observation platform and enjoy the stunning views of the surrounding landscapes that unfurl before you.

12. MÁD SYNAGOGUE



Built in 1795, Mád Synagogue is a truly beautiful Jewish place of worship, and one with a long history. Step inside and immerse yourself in its sacred stillness, marvelling at the wonderful harmony of Baroque architectural styles that gives this building its reputation as one of most beautiful synagogues in Hungary.

22. SÓSTÓ OPEN-AIR MUSEUM, NYÍREGYHÁZA



For those interested in folk culture, the Museum Village is not to be missed, and in particular the various events that the museum offers all year round, including fairs, festive events, gastronomy exhibitions, and much more.

31. ZEMPLÉN ADVENTURE PARK, SÁTORALJÁJHELY



If it's adventure you're after, then look no further! Hike along adventure trails or scale steep climbing walls, ride a bobsleigh down the longest and fastest piste in the country, glide between the Szár and Magas hills on the 1,036-metre zip-line, or just come for a fantastic skiing experience during the winter.

6. FÜZÉR CASTLE



Sat majestically atop a volcanic cone, Füzér Castle is one of the most spectacular fortresses in Hungary, and is listed among the oldest buildings in the country. A wonderful blend of Renaissance, Gothic, and Romantic, the castle is well worth a visit, and in particular its chapel, with its beautiful stained-glass windows.

20. AQUARIUS ADVENTURE AND PARK BATH, NYÍREGYHÁZA



A fantastic time is guaranteed for all at the adventure pool of Sóstó, which is also fully equipped with hot tub and sauna. For visitors looking to rest and recharge, choose from a range of spa pools and massage services, while the more active can take advantage of the wave pool or the giant water slides.

25. MEGYER MOUNTAIN TARN, SÁROSPATAK



A few kilometres from Sárospatak is a small but picturesque mountain lake, formed in the excavation pit of an abandoned millstone mine. The tarn's maximum depth is just 6.5 metres, but the rock walls around it stretch up some 70 metres into the air, their reflections extending out over the water. Follow the trail to the top and take advantage of the contemporary Megyer Hill Lookout for the most majestic views of the lake.

40. WORLD HERITAGE TOKAJ WINE MUSEUM



Visitors to this museum can learn all about the world-famous Hungarian Tokaj wine, including its related viticulture and traditions. The interactive exhibition means that visitors can explore the wonderful Tokaj-Hegyalja region without ever having to leave the exhibition hall, choosing from an adventure on foot, by bike, by car, or even by airship.

8. KÓPOROS WINERY ROW, HERCEGKÚT



Truly one of the hidden treasures of the Zemplén Mountains, the cellars of this Swabian village in Tokaj-Hegyalja are a World Heritage Site. Located just a few kilometres from Sárospatak, the area houses 195 cellars in total, preserving and showcasing this traditional way of life.

21. NYÍREGYHÁZA ZOO



There is always something happening here, which has led to it quickly becoming one of the most popular zoos in Hungary. Ring-tailed lemurs, white tigers, and all manner of endangered species live here in enclosures very similar to their original habitats. Visit the zoo to explore the incredibly realistic environments of the rainforests, the desert, or the savannah.

26. RÁKÓCZI CASTLE, SÁTOROSPATAK



Rákóczi Castle is perhaps the most beautiful late Renaissance castle in Hungary. Part of the dowry of Zsuzsanna Lórántffy, the castle was an important venue for Hungarian independence movements for many years, and its rooms have witnessed a great many decisive moments in Hungarian history.
